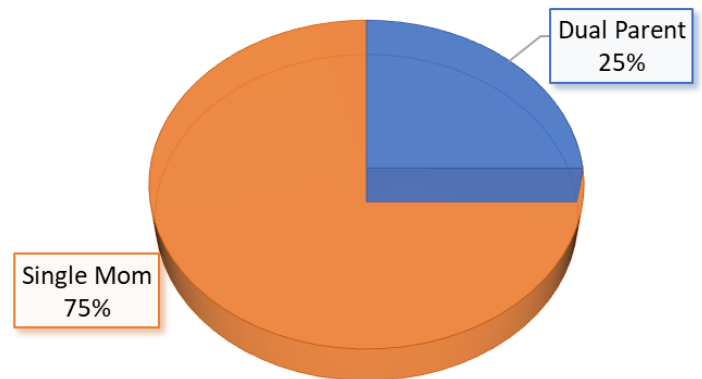

HOUSEHOLD TYPE



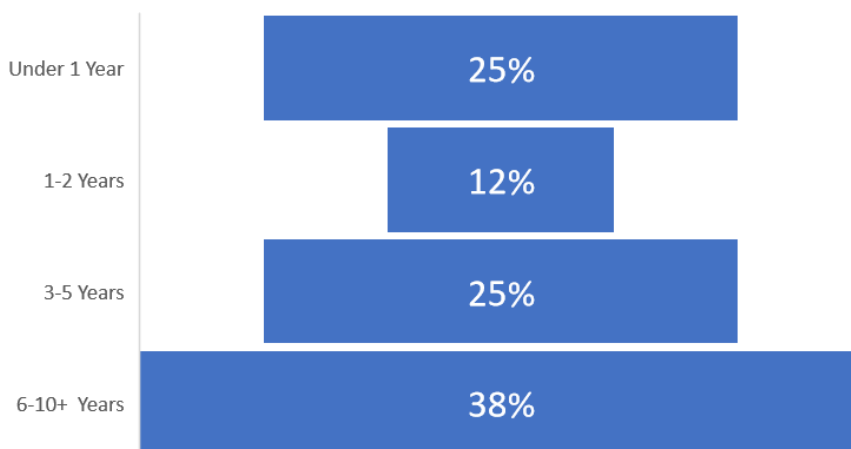
Housing stability is the main goal of the Supportive Housing Program.

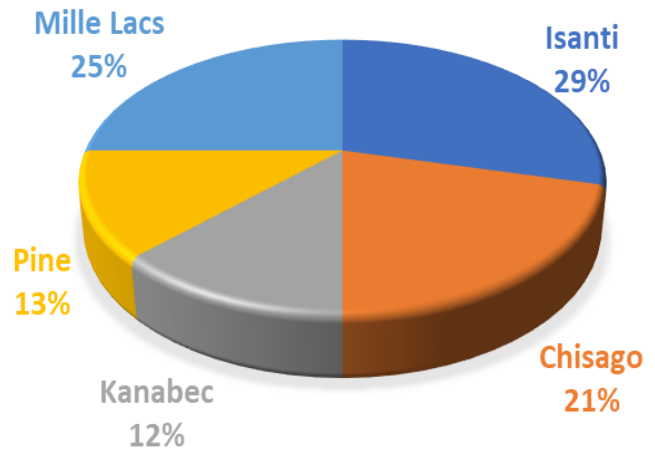

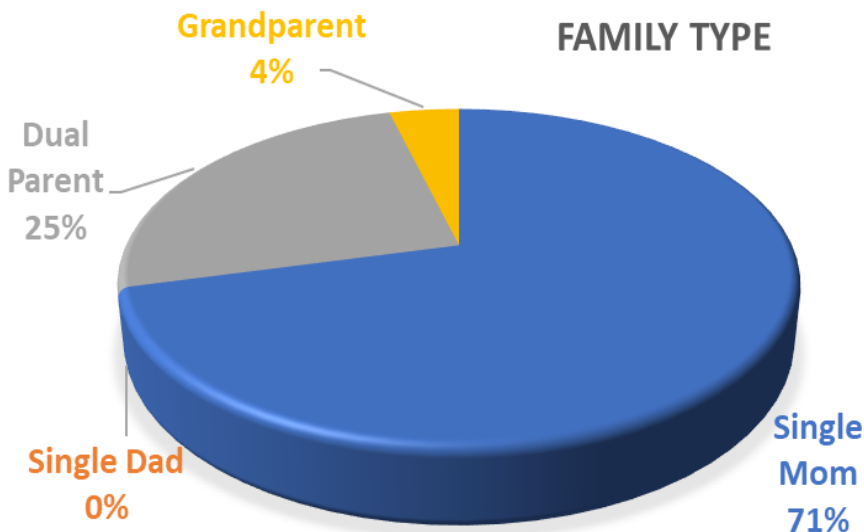
